

## Situation Overview

An earthquake with a magnitude of 7.7 struck near the city of Gaziantep in southeastern Turkey at 4:17 am on Monday, when people were sleeping. It occurred at a depth of 17.9 km. The earthquake was felt in many nearby cities and provinces, as well as neighboring countries. Second earthquake with magnitude of 7.6 struck Elbistan in the following hours, with strong aftershocks continued throughout the day.

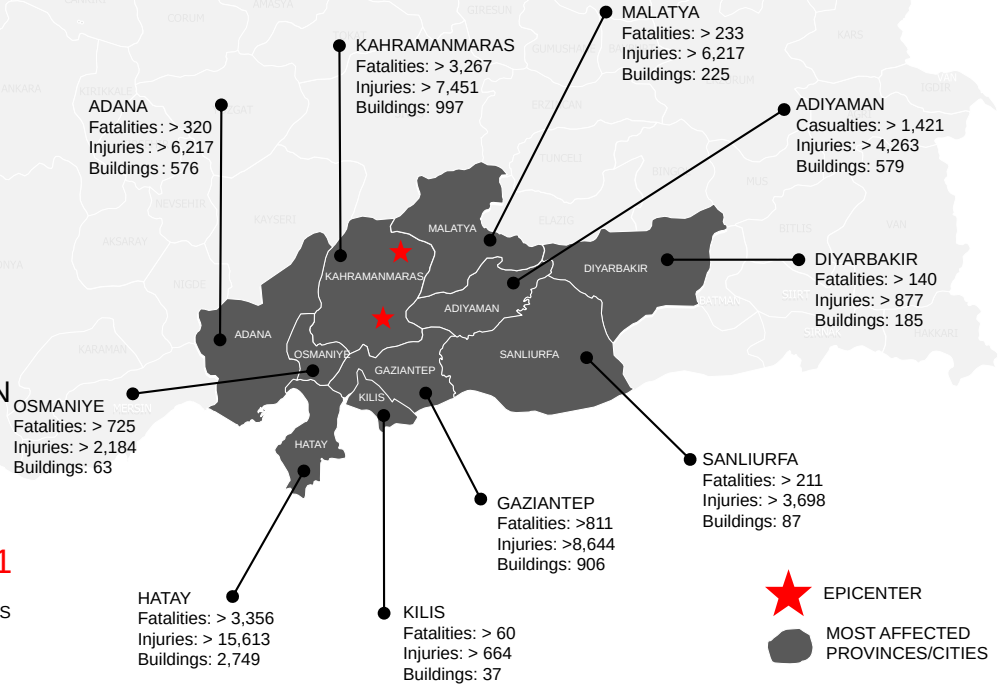

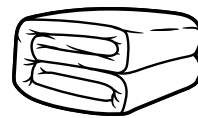
